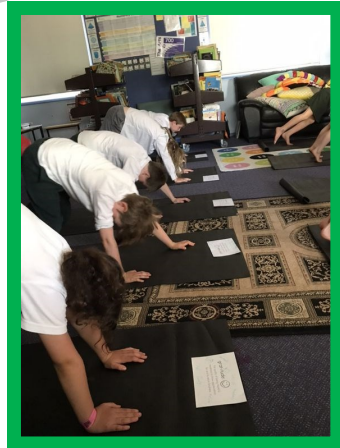

We are continuing to work hard to achieve our goals this term.

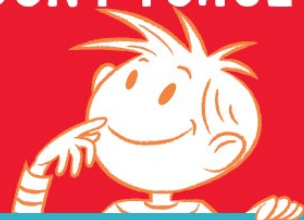


OUTDOOR CLASSROOM DAY

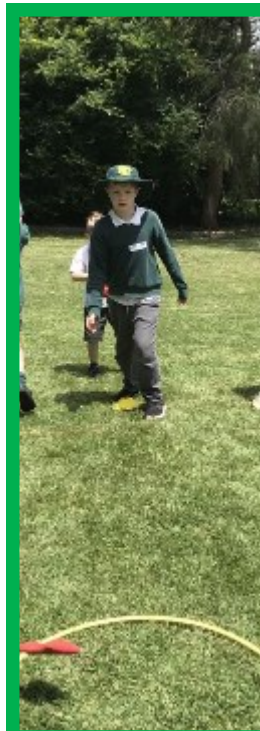
