Our school relay team came first on the day and we wish them all the best as they compete at Regionals in Canberra on 13 September.

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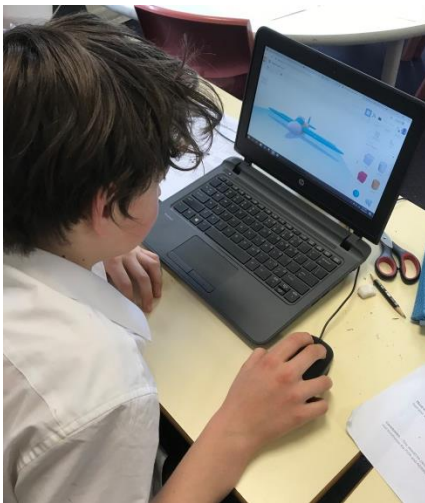
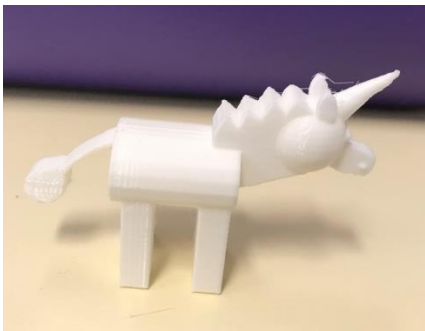
Book Fair, Book Parade and Education Week



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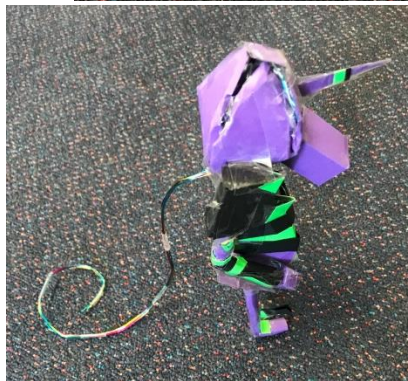
In class:
